1. This week's events are listed below:

1.1) The 2015 ACEP Book Fair will be held between Wednesday 5th and Friday 7th August. The fair will include books from several book companies who will open booths on the ground floor of the Ave Maria Building between 7:30 a.m. and 5:00 p.m. each day.

1.2) The 2015 ACEP ASEAN Fun Fair will be held this Wednesday 5th August between 8:20 - 9:40 a.m. to celebrate ASEAN Day. This activity, which has been arranged by teachers from the Social Studies Department, will be in the courtyard of the Ave Maria Building. Students and teachers are encouraged to wear the traditional clothing of an ASEAN country on Wednesday (Year 7-9 students are not required to wear their Scout uniform).

1.3) ACEP will also conduct its second 'Open House' for the parents of prospective students in the 2016 Academic Year this Wednesday 5th August between 9 a.m. - 12 p.m. Parents will join a meeting in The Trinity Building before they are then taken on a tour of the Ave Maria or Regina Coeli Building to enable them to determine whether ACEP is suitable for their child.

1.4) Monthly Catholic Mass will be held this Friday 7th August after the morning assembly. Everyone is welcome to join.

1.5) ACEP Bowling 2015 will be held this Saturday 8th August at TPD Bowling Alley on Ekachai 93/1. This event is to pay respect to HRH Princess Maha Chakri Sirindhorn on the occasion of her 60th birthday, promote unity amongst members of the ACEP community and raise funds to develop students in multiple aspects of education. 2. Uniform and Hairstyles - All students will have their uniform and hairstyle checked this week to ensure that they comply with the regulations stated in the students' handbook. 3. The Samut Sakhon Provincial Government will conduct a practice for their 'Bike for Mom' event to be held on Sunday 16th August. The practice will start at Samut Sakhon City Hall at 3:00 p.m. on Tuesday 4th August and the route will include Jessadavhitee Road (outside the AC Rama II campus).
