1. Assumption College English Program sincerely thanks everyone from the school community who joined the 'ACEP Bowling 2015' event on Saturday 8th August at TPD Bowling. The proceeds will be used for special learning programs to develop our students.

2. This week's events are listed below:

2.1) There will be a ceremony in the courtyard of the Ave Maria Building to celebrate the birthday of Her Majesty Queen Sirikit, and Thai Mothers' Day, on Tuesday 11th August between 8:10 - 10:20 a.m.. All students, teachers and parents are encouraged to wear clothing which is blue, the colour of Her Majesty. Year 4-6 students are not required to wear their Scout uniform.

Between 2:00 - 3:30 p.m. on Tuesday afternoon, there will be friendly sporting competitions for mothers and ACEP teachers to celebrate Mothers' Day and promote good relations between parents and teachers. All Year 1-6 classes should come downstairs to spectate the sporting competitions at 2:10 p.m. and teachers who supervise the students should take them back to their classrooms at 3:30 p.m. for Homework Help and regular After-School classes.

2.2) Sporting Competitions: During the 2015 Academic Year there will be three types of sporting competitions - swimming, chairball and basketball. The swimming competitions will be for primary and secondary students. Chairball and basketball competitions will be for secondary students only. This week, we ask that parents and teachers cooperate to select students to compete in each colour team. The competitions will be coordinated by Mr. Sichon and will commence next week.

2.3) Wednesday 12th August is a public holiday to allow students to spend time with their family on Mothers' Day. Thursday 13th and Friday 14th August will be normal school days.

2.4) On Thursday 13th August, ACEP will welcome teachers and student representatives from Chakham Kanathorn School in Lamphun. They are due to arrive at 2:00 p.m.

2.5) On Friday 14th August, students from all Year Levels should line up in the courtyard of the Ave Maria Building for a Ceremony to celebrate the Assumption of Virgin of Virgin Mary. The ceremony will commence with a procession of the Virgin Mary statue, making its way to the Ave Maria Building. Parents are welcome to join this assembly.

2.6) Four practice sessions have been planned to prepare students for the ACEP Games which will be held on Saturday 29th August. The practices will be held between 2:00 - 3:30 p.m. on the 14th, 21st, 24th and 26th August on the ground floor of the Ave Maria and Regina Coeli Buildings. On these days, students will learn their normal subjects but each period will be for 40 minutes. Homework Help / Afternoon Homeroom periods will be between 1:40 - 2:00 p.m. for primary and secondary students.
