## 1. Announcements from the Academic Department:

1.1 Thank you to all of the staff and students who contributed to the great success of the 2015 ACEP Science Fair last week in the Regina Coeli Building.

1.2 Midterm exam results (1/2015) will be finalised on Tuesday 25<sup>th</sup> August. Students who did not pass any exams should contact the subject teacher immediately to ensure that they can complete an additional assignment and have their score adjusted.

2. In the afternoon this Monday 24<sup>th</sup> and Wednesday 26<sup>th</sup> August, there will be more practices for the 2015 ACEP Games. On these days students will learn all classes for 40 minutes. Students will meet with their Colour Teams between 2:00 - 3:30 p.m. Afterwards, teachers should take their students back to their classroom until normal home time. There will be regular After-School classes on these days.

The teachers who are preparing students to perform in the opening ceremony should provide the Academic, Student Affairs and Services Departments with details about rehearsals etc.

3. On Friday 28<sup>th</sup> August, the producers of "Comic Ben Boat" on Channel 3 Television will perform a puppet show for Year 1-4 students in the Multipurpose Hall of The Trinity Building. The show covers topics including nutrition and immunity. There will be two sessions, with Year 1-2 students watching the show between 9-10 a.m. and Year 3-4 students watching the show between 10-11 a.m.

4. On Saturday 29<sup>th</sup> August, Assumption College English Program will conduct the annual ACEP Games event between the hours of 7:30 a.m. and 3:00 p.m. on the ACEP Field beside the Regina Coeli Building. All students are expected to be at school, dressed in their team's colour by 7:20 a.m.

Students will first line up with their homeroom teachers, who will check name lists before they prepare for the opening parade on the centre courtyard (red bricks) at 7:30 a.m. The school invites all parents to attend this day and requests that all students stay at the event until the closing ceremony.
