



# Weekly Announcements – Week 17

1. Last week, Year 1-3 students had their Scout Day Camps. The Student Affairs Department would like to thank all of the Thai and foreign teachers who worked together to make these days a success for our students.

## 2. Academic Affairs

2.1) On Wednesday 9<sup>th</sup> September, the Guidance Department has arranged a University Campus Tour for Year 10 and Year 11 students. The students will have the opportunity to visit various faculties that interest them, which will better enable them to make informed decisions about their future tertiary study.

2.2) Teachers from the Mathematics Department have arranged a Mathematics Competition for Year 7 this Wednesday 9<sup>th</sup> September. Immediately after the morning assembly, foreign homeroom teachers should take the Year 7 students to The Trinity Building. Year 7 subject teachers should also go to the Trinity Building that morning to help supervise students during the competition and accompany them back to their classrooms afterwards.

3. On Thursday 10<sup>th</sup> and Friday 11<sup>th</sup> September, Year 4-6 students will join their annual Scout Camp. The camp will be for two days and one night and students will practice life skills that have been taught during their weekly Scout periods.

On Tuesday 8<sup>th</sup> September, Year 4-6 students do not need to wear their Scout uniform. On that day, students will also be given an information letter for parents to sign and return to their child's homeroom teacher. The information sent home on Tuesday will include:

- Due to the camp activities, there will be no regular lessons or after-school classes for Year students 4-6 on these days.
