

BANGKOK BANK SMART STUDENT CARD

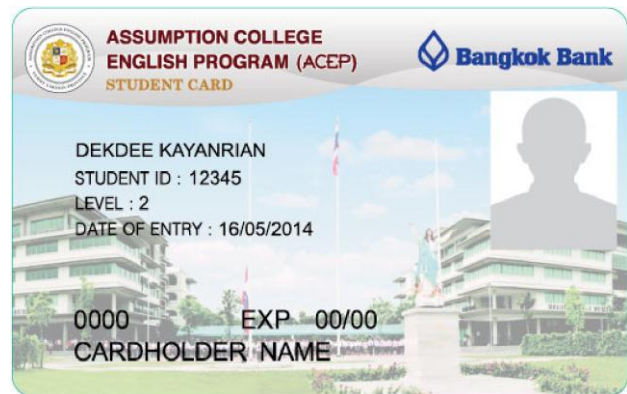
A user guide for primary students and parents

Bangkok Bank and Assumption College English Program co-developed the Smart Student Card for primary students to reduce cash usage while providing more convenient and secure way for campus life. This card can be used to make any purchase at school cafeteria and shops. Students also learn to develop financial discipline and self-responsibility at a young age.

Card details

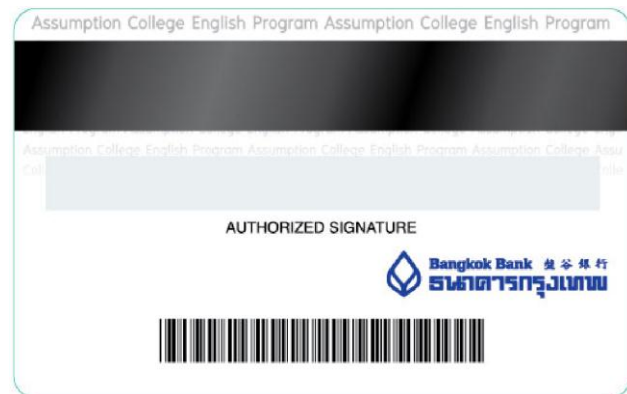
Front

1. School and bank logos
2. School name
3. Color photo of student
4. Name and surname of the student in English
5. Student ID and level
6. Date of entry
7. The Bank's data includes:
 - bank branch code
 - expiry date
 - cardholder name in English



Back

1. Signature panel
2. Magnetic stripe
3. Barcode



Features of the Smart Student Card (for primary students)

- Student ID
- Access Control card*
- Library card for borrowing and returning books*
- E-Purse card for buying food and goods at school**

Remarks * Depending on school system

** Parents and students can top-up the card at the school's top-up points

Benefit of the Smart Student Card (for primary students)

Benefits for parents

- Convenient control of student expenses and safe daily spending.
- No needs to carry cash. Parents can easily top-up the card at school top-up points; students can use the card to make any purchase at school cafeteria and shops.

Benefits for students

- The Smart Student Card is an all-in-one card, no need to carry many cards.
- After parents top-up the card at school top-up points, students can use the card to make any purchase at school cafeteria and shops.
- It is secure as students don't need to carry cash, so the risk of loss or stolen is much reduced.

How to top-up the Smart Student Card (for primary students)

- Parents and students can top-up the card at school top-up points; then students can use the card to pay for food at the cafeteria and purchase goods inside the school.

If the card has been lost or damaged

1. Contact the school
 - Report card loss at school (Contact Finance Department, Trinity Building) and request school certification to contact Bangkok Bank for card replacement.
2. Contact the Bangkok Bank branch*
 - The new card will be issued within two weeks

* Students can use the card for a maximum of three years (Year 1-3 and Year 4-6)

Replacement Card

- 100Bt fee per card

When student status ends

- Return the card and claim the funds stored on the card at school within the time limit set by the school.
