



Weekly Announcements – Week 19

21st September – 25th September, 2015

1. This is the final week of Term 1 before exams next week. Students are encouraged to focus on revision lessons this week to ensure that they are well prepared for their exams. If they have any problems or concerns they should speak with their teachers.

2. Student Affairs will announce the outstanding classes of Term 1 for each Year Level this Wednesday 23rd September. The Thai and foreign teachers from those classes, together with two student representatives, should line up near the stage on Thursday 24th September to receive the award for their class. Primary classes will have their presentation in the Ave Maria Building and secondary classes will have their presentation in the Regina Coeli Building.

3. All students should clear their locker of personal items before this Friday 25th September. Secondary students also need to return their locker key to their homeroom teacher. Students who have lost their key should contact the Student Affairs office on the ground floor the Regina Coeli Building before Wednesday 23rd September.

4. This week there will be no after-school sporting activities except for those with additional fees. The teachers who normally lead the sporting activities will supervise students this week during after-school hours.

- Next week, students from all Year Levels do not have to wear their scout uniform. Also, there will not be any type of after-school classes.
- Primary students will have normal classes on Monday 28th September, except they can go home at 3:20 p.m. on that day.
- Primary students will have exams on two days - Tuesday 29th September and Thursday 1st October. They are not required to be at school on Wednesday 30th September and Friday 2nd October.
- Secondary students will have exams on three days - Monday 28th September, Wednesday 30th September and Friday 2nd October. They are not required to be at school on Tuesday 29th September and Thursday 1st October.

6. Students who have lost any property during Term 1 should check the Lost & Found areas in the Student Affairs office on the ground floor of Ave Maria Building before this Friday 25th September. Any items remaining after that day will be donated to charity.

7. The school respectfully reminds parents that they should not go upstairs to classrooms on school days. If parents wish to speak with a teacher, please make arrangements to meet them on the ground floor by contacting them directly or office staff.

Secondary students are invited to participate in the "Share the Children's Dream" project to commemorate the 300 year anniversary of the death of the **Saint Louis-Marie Grignion de Montfort**, who devoted his life to helping children. The project, which is a joint venture between schools, teachers, students, parents and other community members, is intended to provide poor children with better educational opportunities. It will be conducted at 'Ban Kao Wai' in Rayong province on Saturday 14th November. Students who are interested can sign up at the Student Affairs office on the ground floor of the Regina Coeli Building by Tuesday 22nd September.
